

WHAT DOES MBX DO?

Founded in 2003 by Gary Wayland, the MBX Foundation is dedicated to supporting academic, educational, musical, athletic, and co-curricular programs within the Manhattan Beach Unified School District (MBUSD) in Manhattan Beach, California.

In addition to supporting over fifty booster clubs, the MBX Foundation operates a WASC and NCAA-accredited Summer School, After School Enrichment Programs at six MBUSD campuses, and after-school sports and arts programs at MBMS.

With the revenue from the summer school and after school programs MBX Foundation supports the district through multiple projects and grants each year. In just the past two years we have installed a new Waller Stadium scoreboard, an Aquatic scoreboard/timer, new lights in the auditorium, and resurfaced all turf fields and the track. In addition, we have also given grants to all MBUSD elementary schools, the preschool and many MCHS Booster Clubs.

HOW DOES MBX SUPPORT BOOSTER CLUBS?

- Provides support and officer training
- Oversees banking accounts and transactions
- Provides insurance for camps, fundraisers, summer athletics, VAPA programs and banquets
- Promotes merchandise sales and fundraisers via MBUSD channels
- Designs and distributes the MBX Newsletter
- Manages registrations and online payment systems
- Plans, funds and purchases cap ex projects
- Upgrades and maintains fields and facilities
- Registers as a charitable organization yearly allowing Boosters non-profit status
- Conducts monthly reconciliations and yearly audit
- Holds SCO meetings
- Facilitates the set up and launch of Square stores for sales
- Reviews and submits ask and SCO agreement to district for approval and school board discussion and vote
- Sets up the booster ASK
